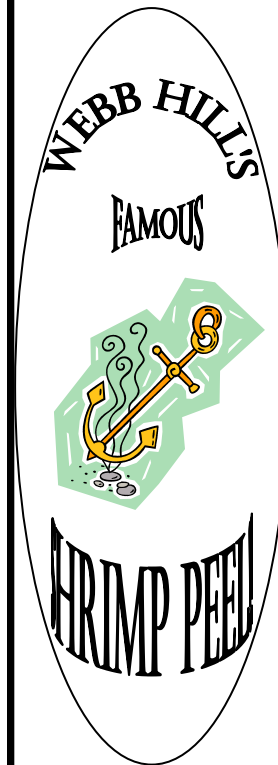

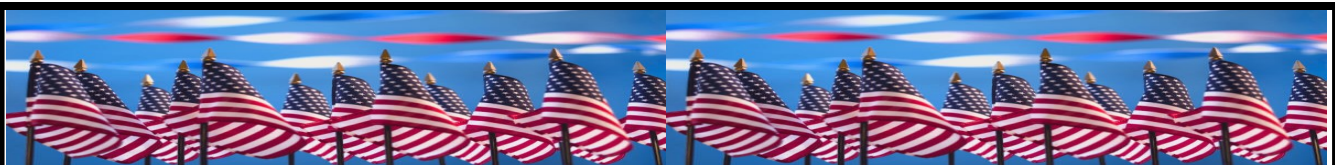

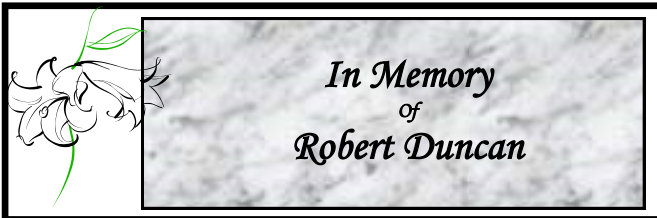
We need your support in August, so be sure and "come on out". Labor Day is just around the corner. Make your plans to come to our All American Buffet on Saturday, September 3rd.
