I also want to thank Jenny Greene and Pat Reddell for leading the hydrobics classes. I know that all who participated had a great time.

The maintenance staff continues to amaze me as to their accomplishments. Trinten has made great headway with finding and repairing "lost" irrigation heads, and the other guys have worked so hard keeping the course watered and manicured. I am also happy to report that the damage to the greens from the February 2021 below zero freeze has *nearly* recovered 100%. We are in a good place as we come to the end of the summer. Wade assures me that 2023 will be better yet! Thank you guys for ALL of your hard work.

As mentioned, maintenance has been very active. Just keeping up with irrigating the course has been crazy. We've been running our deep well which replenishes the irrigation lake non-stop since June to maintain the lake level from nightly watering. Hopefully, the upcoming predicted rains will bring us some relief as the deep well adds an additional \$2K a month to our electricity bill. Wade has also been actively spraying herbicide—trying to kill the patches of nutsedge and Dallis grass all over the course. Maintaining 223 acres seems to be never ending!

We want to welcome Neal White to the golf shop. He will be helping out weekdays. Please introduce yourself and welcome to him. We are happy to have him helping us. We also want to wish Robert Huckaby a speedy recover from recent surgery, and Jeff Murphey well, as he moves onto another work venture. Thank you all for your help.

I hope everyone has enjoyed this slightly cooler weather, and the little rains we have been getting. It is so great for August. Let's hope this fall is not too bad, and we can avoid any major winter freezes this year.

Our entire maintenance crew has worked their behinds off this year to get the golf course where it is today, and as long as nothing drastic happens this winter, the crew will start out with a good base for next year. They plan to work on very specific areas to improve in 2023.

As the Bermuda grass begins transitioning into dormancy this fall/winter, the best thing you can do for your course is to stay off the fairways as much as possible using the 90° rule. Cart tire damage can be minimized if you pay close attention to this. Your help is greatly appreciated in maintaining the course.

We have truly had a remarkable summer of activities, and we appreciate everyone's use of the club. Let's continue through the fall!

Here's just a few things happening in September: on Friday, September 9 The Greenville chamber of commerce will be hosting their double shotgun start annual event. They have a 7:30 AM and a 1:30 PM start, so we will be closed that day for golf. Also on Thursday, September 22 we will be hosting a ladies league outing that morning. Check with us about closing the course as time progresses; right now, it's to be determined. On September 17 and 18th we will be having our men's senior club championship open to all members 50 and over. Flighting will be done by age groups; so, we need you to sign up, and be sure and give us your age.
