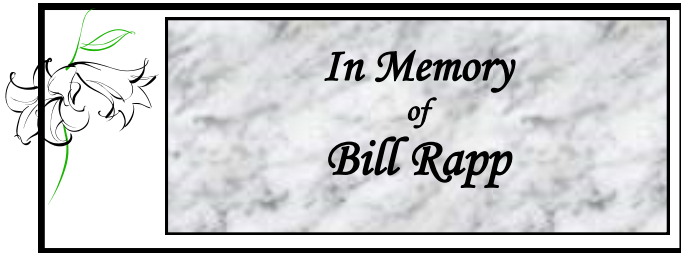
On Friday, November 10th, we will have our famous Filet mignon Steaks with our delicious roasted salmon. This is always a favorite with our members. Try to come to it if you can.
