Superintendent's Notes

....From Wade Toeplitz

For a while I thought the rain would never stop. It made it impossible for us to accomplish anything, and I've lost count of the new washes we have out on the course. Sprigs and sod were put off for over a month due to us or the farm being rained out. Now, summer is here and it's hot and dry. Wish I could see some rain in the future, but I believe the spigot has been turned off for a while. It did, however, give us plenty of water for the recent grow in and growing season as well as green up the whole course. We were closed so many days due to rain, and I feel it gave the course a much needed brake.

Sprigs and sod were completed on the 13th and 14th of June are both looking great. Not sure of opening date for greens, but we are shooting for the end of July or first part of August. That's optimistic, but I'm very happy with what I see. It's a lot of work from start to finish, and I feel we have done an amazing job thru this process. We have been able to make things happen with minimal tools and a skeleton crew. Many cultural practices and daily maintenance duties had to be put to the side to be able to get greens and sod ready. The last two weeks we have been able to get out and make the course look great.

Please bare with us for a while on the fairways and tees. Our unit is down that we use to mow those areas, and it's looking like it could be a while before its back up and running. A fairway unit is around 125K and over a year out if purchased. We are having to use other methods to mow tees and fairways and they just simply don't do as good of a job or mow the turf low enough. This also takes away a unit to help keep the rough under control. We seem to always figure out a way.

Please thank the crew for their hard work, and pray for the ones who have been ill or injured. Allen is still not feeling well following his recent battle with cancer. He's been a huge part of this course for over 35 years. Trinten is out for several weeks with horrible chainsaw injury to his ankle. He's been another huge part of this crew. Lastly, Daren has had some recent health issues and will need to be out often and lots of rest. I couldn't make this happen without these guys.

Thank you all for the much needed support. With that support it just pushes us harder to make this course amazing.

As per Charles and Shirley's wishes, it is my desire to continue their legacy here on the hill. My goal, along with our staff, is to offer the best golfing and food service possible to you, our Webb Hill family. Thank you so much for your continued support!

In addition to the sadness of Shirley's passing, we've had a difficult last couple of months due to our greens rebuilding project.

I'm happy to say that after weeks of waiting due mainly to weather issues, we received our loads of sprigs and sod on the 13th and 14th of June. It was amazing to watch the process take place as the team from Houston came in and completed the work in record time.

A special thanks to our maintenance staff who has worked so hard to get ready for this process and then has gone above and beyond to see that the grow-in from the sprigging and sodding is successful. Wade you have been absolutely amazing! Thank you all!

Since our decision to make these improvements in April and going to temporary greens, needless to say, our revenue has plummeted due to lack of daily play. So far, we have spent over \$125,000 for fumigation, dirt work, sprigs, sprigging and sod. This, along with daily fee revenue being down by 75% has made our finances concerning. I'm optimistic that there are much better days ahead...if we can just make it through this growing-in process. Thank you SO MUCH for your continued support.

I want to extend a special "Thank You", to several people who have anonymously made donations to the club during this time. We had one member donate a \$43K dollar piece of equipment that promises to make the greens so much better after the grown-in process. We also had another member donate \$5K toward the renovation project. I'm speechless for your generosity... It is so appreciated at this time.

Congratulations to Wade on his third anniversary as greens superintendent here on the hill. He continues to impress me with his work ethic and love for Webb Hill. Thank you for all you do!
