Superintendent's Notes

....From Wade Toeplitz

I hope everyone is as excited as I am about the greens. The last few weeks have been long and stressful to say the least. Lots of working before sun comes up and after the sun goes down. The results I've seen are amazing! I'm not surprised because I know how hard we have pushed them, and the crew has been on point. As I'm putting this newsletter together it's my first day of vacation for me and my family. I need it and can't wait to get back and see how far along the greens have come as it's hard to tell when you see them on a daily basis. I can assure you that we are very close. Of the many grow-ins I've completed, this has been one of the quickest for the most part.

The rest of the course is really starting to shape up as well. Charles has been working hard on keeping the fairways under control and adding sand where needed to fill in the lows or compacted areas. Those spots are looking great and will only get better. Greens are the number one area of focus but fairways have always been a big one for me too. They need lots of water, soil, compaction relief, fertilizer and herbicide. None of these are very abundant either. The next big area of concern on fairways is 17. Soon we will start to smooth those large bare areas out and try to scrounge up some soil as it's built on rock. Hopefully get some much needed grass growing in that area. It's such a great thing to look down a grass covered fairway.

Health issues still tend to take a toll on the crew. We definitely have to take care of each other and cover when one is out. Hope to see Trinten back soon, but I know he will be super light duty when he does. He's been a huge part of keeping this irrigation going. I'll never stop saying this, but irrigation here is a full-time job. I wish I had all that time back working on irrigation to put towards other things to better the course. Allen, as well, is still battling daily. As long as he's here there are no breaks because there is constantly those repairs to be made. Not to mention the daily maintenance of things to keep going.

I'm going to have a better idea of when we open greens when I get back from vacation, and I believe we are still on track for mid-August. Some are going to be ready sooner but you always have that one that lags behind. Thank you all for your patience, and we will hopefully see you soon. Stay cool!
