I'm sure most know, but just in case, we are back on our greens full time! We are still in the grow-in process but getting better every week. We first focus on getting full coverage and then smoothness and speed. There were a few issues overall, but I'm pleased. Grow-ins are not easy. Speed may take us some time to get to a happy medium. Not too slow and not too fast is the goal. I get a lot of different request when it comes to speed so that's a big concern. It has been great seeing so many golfers coming out, and I even got to play a round myself. Please tell your friends and family and come out and enjoy the course. The weather is about to be perfect for golf.

We are still working hard on keeping up with everything else, and I hope you've noticed. Fairways and tees are improving weekly as well and will look even better when we receive our new fairway unit. I'm told delivery last week of August. One more thing off my list of wants. Hopefully, next year we can look into greens mowers and some more much needed irrigation improvements. Things don't always go as planned, and other things may need to be replaced before.

I've recently been asked, and noticed myself about the need of new flags, flagsticks, reflectors and cups. The price of these items totals over \$2,000.
