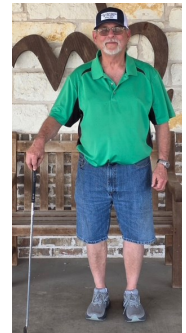


ACE UPDATE!

Spring has finally sprung! At least that's what the calendar says. If you've been outside lately, you'll see it's still on the chilly side, and the wind will blow you into next year. You can bet that if it's windy in towns near by that the wind is even stronger on the hill. Hard to get anything accomplished in these times. It's almost impossible to even keep a flag in the hole and several other objects have been relocated.

So far we are starting to slowly see the course come to life. A little more green is showing it's face daily. You will notice that other courses in the metroplex tend to green up before we do due to warmer soil temperatures or possibly different varieties of grass. So don't be alarmed when we aren't on the same schedule. Our greens are looking great, and I can't wait to see the progress the next few weeks. The greens covers did a fantastic job at protecting the greens during the harsh weather events.

Now is the time that everything starts for us, and it happens almost all at once. Mowing as well as firing up the irrigation have begun. Expect to see the crew out in full force and possibly some water running during the round. It's the only way we can stay on schedule and service the system. It's a very delicate system, and I'm not sure I can stress this enough.

I feel I do need to rant a little bit. I noticed today as I was applying the first fertilization to the greens that there is a substantial amount of unrepaired ball marks and a few divots on the greens. Divots should never be on the greens. There are also several ruts throughout the course from carts after a heavy rain. Many of the ropes have been moved and driven thru or even driven over. Our no cart signs are disappearing, breaking or being driven over as well. We also haven't had to fill divot mix in a while which means there not being used. Please help us to take care of the course!

Thank you all again and remember course closings every Tuesday so we can perform some much needed maintenance and repairs without disruption. This is very important to be able to maintain the best playing conditions possible.
