Superintendent's Notes

.....From Wade Toeplitz

Hard to believe September is here. We have barely had any real heat till just the last 2 or 3 weeks. The course is looking great for August, but it has started to show the typical heat stress we always have this time of year. Before we know it fall will arrive. This season has really gone by quickly. I can't wait to see what the course will look like in the next few weeks with some cooler weather.

So many projects have been completed this season out on the course and I'm super happy with how well the fairways are coming along. Only a few irrigation heads to repair in the fairways and get rid of the hard to beat nutgrass. If you don't know, herbicide for nutgrass is very pricey costing us upwards of \$6K per application and taking typically 2 applications to rid of it. Pre-emergent for nutgrass is double that amount.

The course has been beyond busy and becoming way more of a challenge to get things done. So please bare with us. Some days we tend to get behind and get in the way. You may have to play thru a green with extra sand or the cups not being perfect. We do what we can with what we have and I believe fairly well. We love seeing the course as busy as it is.

Don't forget to check those calendars the next few weeks. We have lots of tournaments coming up. Some really great tournament that we love to host and some new I feel are going to be great as well. Also, don't forget about the last day of pool open on Labor day. One last chance for a dip. Mark did a great job taking it over this year and I thank him.

I also have to thank Scott for all his help and for allowing us to run with it. He is great to work for and loves this place more than anyone. It wouldn't be what it is without his support. He has been beyond generous in purchasing the things and equipment we need to be successful. Running a golf course is not cheap and or easy!
