From Your Course Superintendent...

Wade Toeplitz

Here's to another great season. In my eyes, probably the best we've had in my 4 years at the hill. The course was beyond busy. Sometimes too busy at that. But I'll take it over a slow day or week any time. Be warned, if it continues to stay this busy it will almost be mandatory we close one day a week. I'm super strict on some cultural practices we perform out here and it will only help us to continue to better your golfing experience.

I know this time of year our greens tend to get lightning fast. We are in the process of slowly raising the height of cut but if growth has really slowed then we may not achieve the speed or height we are looking for. We may go through some days here and there that the smoothness isn't at it's best. I for one love a fast green but I can also agree Webb Hill has some of the most challenging greens around. This causes confusion with golfers and they call them inconsistent. I say, that's golf.

Leaves are certainly falling and changing colors. Leaf cleanup and shredding of native areas is right around the corner. We plan on getting several more areas this winter as well as some areas that were done in the past but I decided not to since it would have created more washing. The areas in question have established a significant amount of grass now and I feel will be able to hold up to the large amounts of water that runs through the course.

Our first round of pre-emergent has been done along with a mix to cleanup all broadleaves. Looks as if that is working and the weed pressure on the course is minimal. Hopefully the weather will cooperate in the next few weeks so can go out with my second application to prolong our weed control for the winter. Weed pressure on the greens have been great as well.

I have to say there was a great turnout for the Love Like Jarrett inaugural golf tournament. So glad we could host and can't wait for next year.

Thank you all again, members and guest. Please continue to bring out friends and family to play and show them around. We love and need the support and enjoy seeing everyone.
